A Quick Overview

Questions to Ask:

- What do you think the lost sheep felt like when it was all alone and away from the rest of the flock?
- Can you remember a time when you felt lost or left out? How did that make you feel?
- Why is it important to help others who might be feeling lonely or lost?

- Would you rather find a treasure chest or discover a hidden cave?
- Would you rather eat spaghetti with chocolate sauce or ice cream with pickles?

Activity
